Mission Statement

The mission of Friends of Todai, Inc. (FOTI), a section 501(c)(3) organization, is to promote charitable, educational and scientific activities in the United States through the support of joint/collaborative research and educational activities between The University of Tokyo ("Todai") and U.S. academic institutions conducted in the U.S.

Primary Uses of Funds

The initial plan of FOTI includes awarding grants to support U.S. educational and scientific activities initiated by Todai, such as the Todai-Yale Initiative, in which Todai and Yale University are engaged in a joint project located on the New Haven campus involving the humanities and social sciences (<http://todai-yale.jp/index.html>). Todai is also in discussions with other U.S. universities to conduct collaborative projects in science, engineering, medicine, and other fields. We believe that through these "academic satellites," Todai will be able to contribute most effectively to the global advancement of knowledge.

FOTI support is provided primarily to non-profit (Section 501(c)(3)) organizations in the United States in the form of grants for research, lectures, workshops, publications, exhibitions and other activities which promote FOTI's mission. FOTI does not provide financial support to Todai or any other foreign university or institution.

The Board of Directors will determine which projects will be funded based on Grant Making Guidelines to be approved by the Board.
